

Data Science for Women Summer Camp

July 13-16, 2021 9 am – 12:30 pm

The Translational Data Analytics Institute hosts a free summer camp that introduces young women to data science and analytics. Data is all around us, and data science and analytics is an exciting, fast-growing field centered around how we discover new knowledge from that data. Students who learn these skills can combine them with an unimaginably wide range of interests, from business and biology, to health care and education, to city planning and social services.

Young women attending schools in Ohio and who are entering grades 8, 9, or 10 in autumn 2021 are encouraged to apply. We'll focus on how data is used, hear from inspiring women in data science, discuss how gender and racial stereotypes affect our daily lives, and take on fun data challenges together. Up to 50 people will be selected for the camp. Acceptance packets will be sent in late May with more information.

The camp will be 100% virtual for 2021. Access to a laptop / tablet and reliable internet is needed, but we are committed to working through these accommodations with you. Email us at tdai@osu.edu to discuss what options we have to help you attend.

An application does not guarantee admittance.




