Process and Evaluation

Sponsorship comes in two forms – financial (up to \$2,500) or in-kind – for events taking place *within one year of application*. Applicants should carefully review the Co-sponsorship Guidelines prior to completing this form. Applications are due biannually on **Sept. 15** and **Feb. 1**. Those selected for funding are typically notified of sponsorship decisions within 6 weeks of the submission deadline.

All funding decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

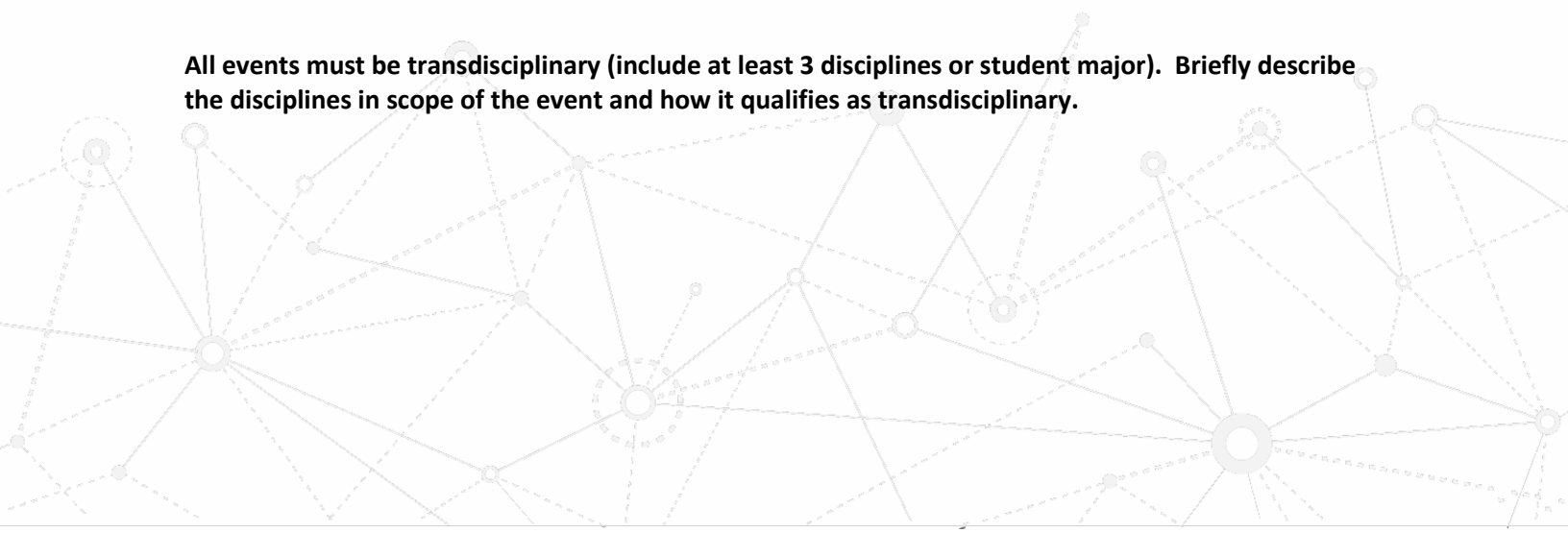
